EU's 5G Toolbox

- Spelt out supplier specific vulnerabilities, including likelihood of being subject to interference by Government lack of democratic checks and balances
- As well as overall quality of products and cybersecurity practices ability to assure supply



5G Infrastructure in Europe


2020 is a decisive year for Huawei in the EU*

Some countries have excluded the supplier from their 5G build up, others are undecided

- No restrictions in place or expected
- Partial restrictions due to carriers' choice
- Partial restrictions in place or expected
- Huawei being de-facto excluded
- Undecided

- 'Coercive' diplomacy




Europe's Response?
